Just a line to thank you for your expertise in fitting my new knee. I was amazed at the tiny, neat scar when the dressing came off. I was expecting one twice as long & possibly keloid as I still have one of those from a broken achilles tendon 30 plus years ago.

Five days after the operation I had all but abandoned the crutches and concentrated on the, I must admit, teeth grittingly painful knee flexions. Three weeks on and they very suddenly became much easier and now, four weeks on are as easy as the other exercises.

I have days when I can walk normally & without looking

like John Wayne which is fantastic.
So I feel I'm nearly there which I'm
thrilled about. Being rather impatient
I was dreading the recovery time and
it was one reason I put the operation
off for so long.

This time of year was definitely
a good choice weather wise as I'm
not so tempted to be outside and
possibly doing more than I should right
now.
